



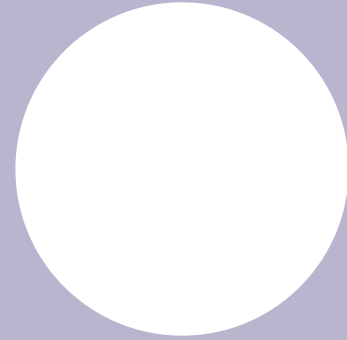
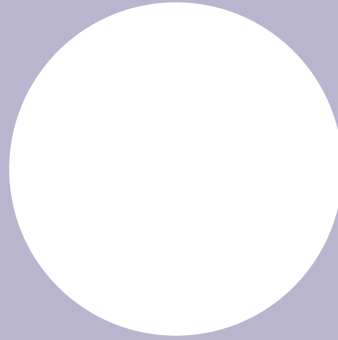

“We are so proud to support the hospital because it touches everyone’s life at one time or another,” said Tim. “And having great health care on the local level enhances our community’s livability in a tremendous way.”

Thanks to the generous contributions of Tim, Judie and many other donors like them, the Foundation is able to assist the hospital, and ultimately the community, by providing staff education, helping patients in need and purchasing equipment.

“In health care, the demands of new technology and staff training are enormous, and the hospital needs that extra boost of funding that the Foundation provides,” said Tim.

## Scholarships Are #1

Stephanie Casey is a “race walk” star and medical student at Des Moines University in Iowa. Ranked fifth in the U.S. in race walking, she has competed in World Cup competition, as well as the recent Olympic trials held in Eugene.

On the surface, racing and studying could be considered solo pursuits, but Stephanie will tell you that both take a lot of teamwork.

And recently, the Salem Hospital Foundation became another teammate of hers.

Stephanie is the 2008 recipient of the first Sewell Family Scholarship, awarded to a nursing or medical school student.

“Some medical school graduates decide on a specialty because of the money – and

with good reason, because medical school debt can be \$250,000 or more,” said Stephanie. “I’m grateful to the Foundation for the scholarship because it will give me more freedom to choose a field of medicine based solely on my passion.”

*Since the scholarship program began over 40 years ago, the Salem Hospital Foundation has awarded over \$1.3 million to students in our community pursuing careers in the health care field. In 2008, 81 students received scholarships totaling \$136,400.*

At this point in school, Stephanie is interested in primary care, family practice or emergency medicine.

Self described as a quiet, shy and “boring middle child,” Stephanie has made her mark in the world by doing, not just talking.

While at OSU, she and her husband became lead cooks at a non-profit organization called *Stone Soup*, which provides free meals to those in need. She also volunteered at *IMPACT*, a physical education program for children with disabilities.

“I spent time mainly with a girl who had autism, and during the year we worked together I saw her learn to run, jump and swim,” said Stephanie. “Each week I saw children overcome the odds and accomplish amazing things, and it taught me to never underestimate people.”

And that is just one of the traits Stephanie hopes will stick with her when she becomes a physician.

“I’m thrilled to have been chosen as one of the recipients of the Foundation scholarship,” she said. “And when I become a physician, I hope I can give back as much as others have given me.”

Because in Stephanie’s world, remember, it’s all about teamwork.

# From Rendering to Reality

## HEALTH EDUCATION CENTER CAMPAIGN EXCEEDS GOAL

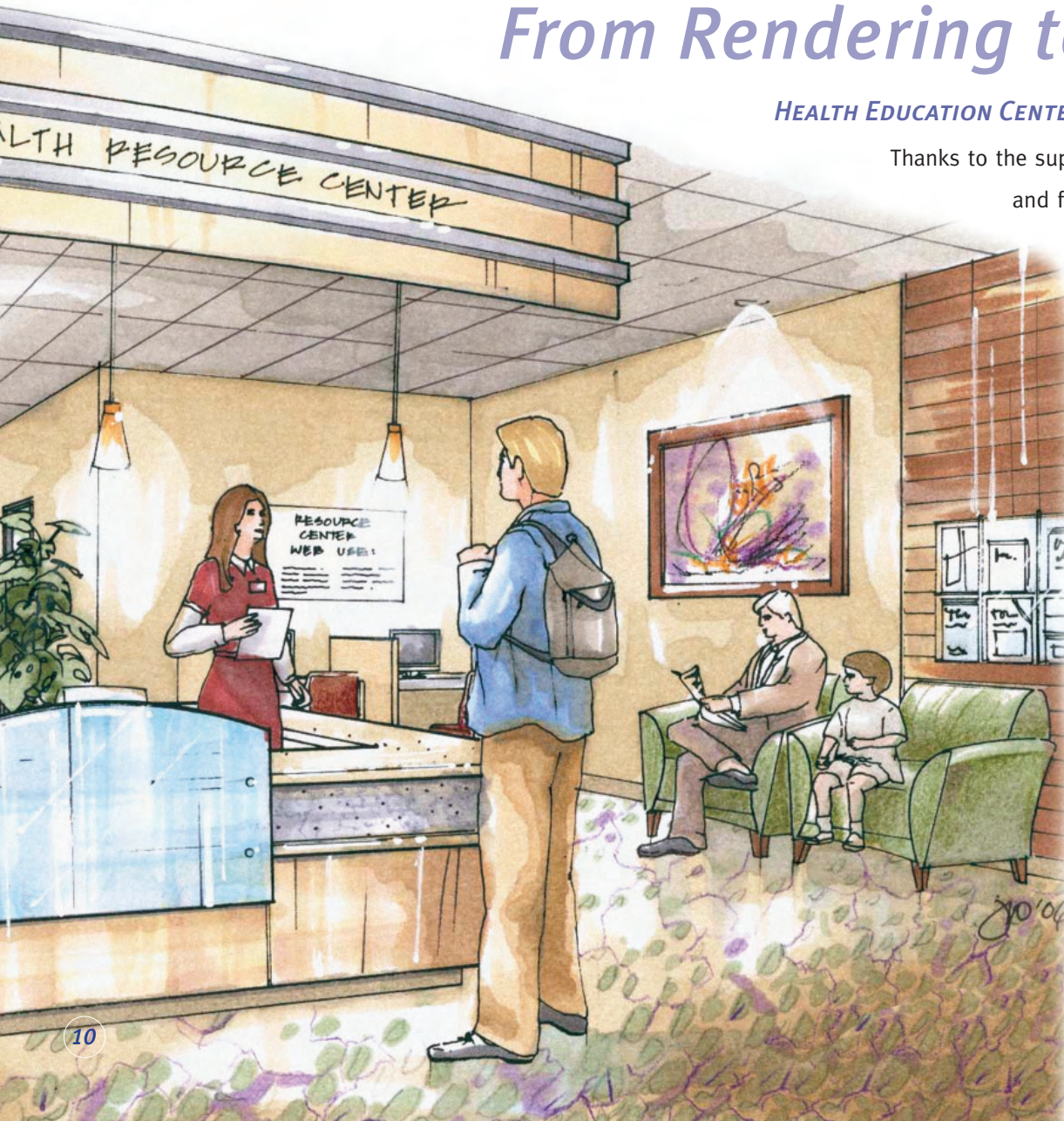
Thanks to the support of close to 1,200 of our partners, neighbors and friends, the Foundation recently completed its

first ever capital campaign to create a new Community Health Education Center (CHEC).

The campaign exceeded the \$3.5 million goal by raising just over \$4 million.

“The generosity of the community in general, hospital employees, our local medical professionals and many local business people has been truly overwhelming,” said Jim Griggs, Foundation Board Chair. “Thanks to their support, we will now be able to offer a user friendly and professionally staffed resource center where

anyone can find reliable information about their health or the health of friends and family members.”

Gifts to the project include \$150,000 from hospital employees, over \$2.3 million from community members and corporations, \$270,000 in grants and over \$1.2 million from active and retired physicians and the Mid-Valley Independent Physicians Association (MVIPA).

“The Health Education Center will provide a unique opportunity for Marion and Polk County residents to access relevant health care information in one convenient location,” said Jan Buffa, Foundation Board Member and CEO of the Mid-Valley Independent Physicians Association. “I sincerely appreciate each and every dollar contributed by all of our physician members and generously matched by MVIPA.”

Major grants to the project included \$100,000 from the Ann and Bill Swindells Charitable Trust and a \$75,000 matching grant from The Collins Foundation.

“A large part of this campaign has been about letting people know that everyone can make a difference, no matter how small or large their contribution,” said Martin Morris, the Foundation’s Chief Development Officer. “This is the first time the Foundation has conducted a capital campaign, and to exceed our goal by \$500,000 shows that our community believes in not only having access to quality health care, but also access to quality health education.”

## *Year-End Wrap Up*

### *MATTERS OF THE HEART*

Imagine finding out something is wrong with your heart. You could need surgery. Or medication. Or perhaps both. Either way, you'll probably have a lot of questions. So to help answer some of those questions, staff from the hospital's cardiac services and cardiac rehabilitation program put together a Cardiac Resource Guide that is filled with just about anything a heart patient and their family could want to know. Information is included on what to do before and after surgery, and what to expect from your hospital stay, as well as sections on medications, cardiac rehabilitation, healthy heart choices and lifestyle changes. The guide was created in a three-ring binder format so information specific to each patient's condition could be added.

"This guide is really a comprehensive book that has each patient's education "prescription" with specific chapters marked for them to read," said Lori James Nielsen, Director of Cardiac Services.

The Foundation provided \$9,500 to assist with the creation of the guides.

### *RESOURCES FOR CANCER PATIENTS*

Clara Graham knew that living with cancer wasn't easy, but it was especially difficult for people trying to survive on a fixed income.

She wanted to help.

Thanks to a generous gift from her estate to the Salem Hospital Foundation,



when she died, the Clara Graham Endowment Fund was established to assist cancer patients needing financial help.

One-time gifts averaging \$250 are given to patients needing things such as pain medication, equipment rental, food, electric bills, or transportation. Need is evaluated by hospital staff involved in caring for cancer patients.

Last year alone, the Foundation awarded \$25,000 in grants from the Clara Graham fund.

### ONE STEP AT A TIME

For people who have tried numerous weight loss treatments such as diet, exercise, behavior modification and pills, but are still unsuccessful in achieving and, more importantly, maintaining long-lasting weight loss, bariatric surgery is now an option at Salem Hospital.

Once patients have qualified for the surgery based on a detailed assessment, they must complete a number of requirements, including walking 10,000 steps a day prior to surgery. It has been shown that walking reduces the risk of complications and helps patients recover quicker. Also, walking before surgery helps establish exercise activity and lifestyle changes that patients need to keep up after surgery.

To help bariatric patients with their quest for good health, the Foundation purchased 75 pedometers.

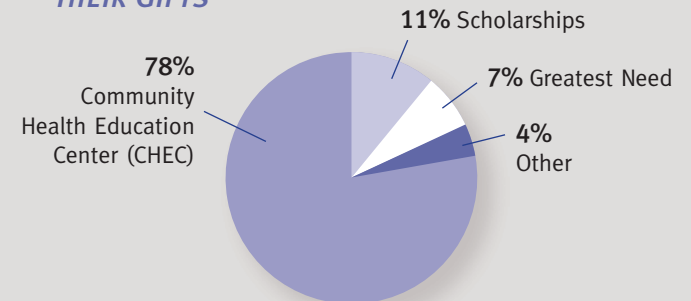
