Rapid Testing Criteria:

- **Symptomatic** employee or medical provider
- **Asymptomatic** employee or medical provider with a high risk exposure and an inability to self isolate.

Routine Testing Criteria:

- **Asymptomatic** employee or medical staff

Option 1: Reference Lab Testing
Typically resulted within 7 days
Order LAB4144
Location: Regional Lab or West Valley Hospital

Criteria for Routine Testing

- General symptomatic patients seen in clinic or virtual

Asymptomatic criteria

- Close contact with a laboratory confirmed COVID test
- Essential frontline workers
- Migrant/seasonal agricultural workers upon arrival in OR
- People who identify Black, African -American, Latino, Latina, Latin X, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian, Asian-American or Pacific Islander
- People who identify as having a disability
- People whose first language is not English
- Farmworker housing or migrant/seasonal worker
- Fishing boats
- Exposure from group living situations
 - Nursing Homes
 - Adult foster homes
 - Group homes
 - Prisons

Option 1: Reference Lab Testing
Typically resulted within 7 days
Order LAB4144 2019 Novel Coronavirus SARS COV...
Location: Regional Lab
Special Instructions:
Patients should pull into designated Park & Swab space and call phone number on sign to notify of arrival.
Note: Symptomatic patients seen virtually do not need to go to a respiratory clinic for testing. They may receive services at Regional Lab Park & Swab.

Option 2: Point of Care Testing (in clinic)
Performed in clinic, when available.

Use clinical judgement for rapid testing
Order CMA0014
Location: Perform test in clinic with visit

Criteria for Rapid Testing
Resulted within 24 Hours
May use POC test in clinic, when available.

- Travel restriction requirement
- Return to work requests
- OHA referrals
- OB for delivery
- Any non in-house testing requiring 72 ours or less turnaround

Note about Point of Care Testing:
Negative results when testing is performed on the Abbott ID Now as POC should be considered in the context of a patient’s recent exposures, history and the presence of clinical signs and symptoms. Negative results should be treated as presumptive and, if inconsistent with clinical signs and symptoms, should be tested with a different method. Recollect with nasopharyngeal swab in transport media and order LAB4144.
