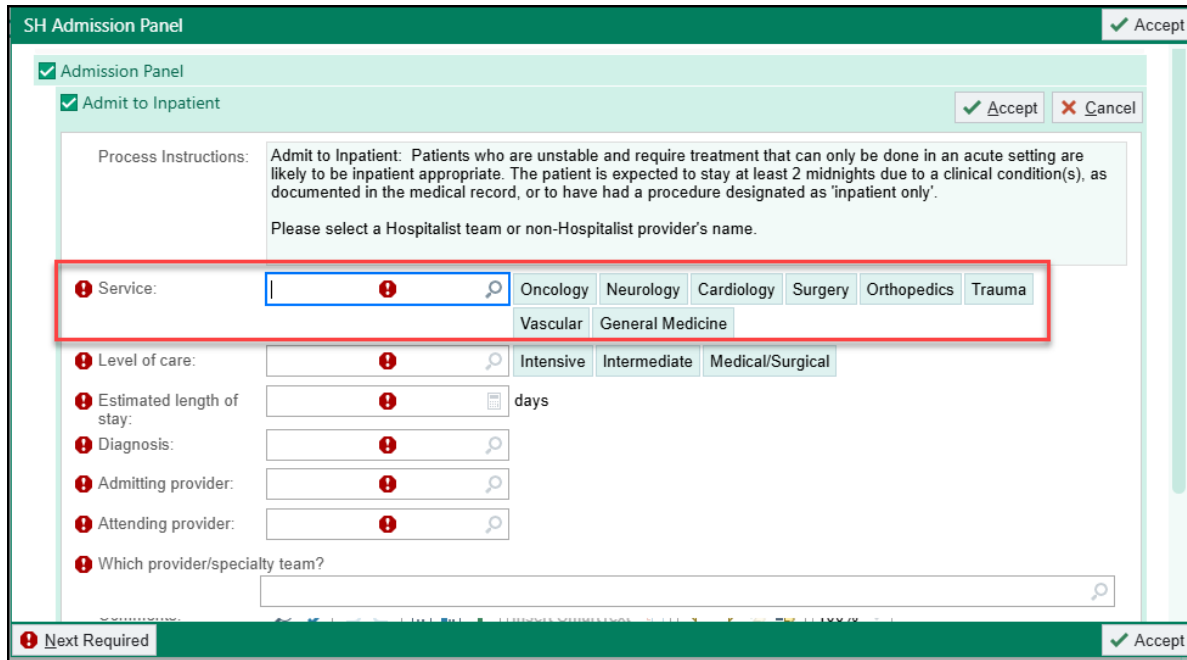


## New Service Buttons

Requested Service Buttons	Example
Oncology	Active treatment for cancer, oncology on service, complications related to cancer treatment, hematologic emergency
Neurology	New stroke, neuro condition, new onset seizure, brain and spine surgery
Cardiology	Post angio w/intervention, all SCAI Stage B and above, titrating cardiac gtts, STEMI, NSTEMI, CT Surgery
Surgery	On surgery schedule, gen surgery, bariatrics, gyn, plastics, TRACS B, urology, ENT
Orthopedics	Joint center, orthopedic surgeons, ground level fall with fracture, podiatry
Trauma	TRACS A
Vascular	Vascular
General Medicine	Pulm, GI, neph, endo, AMS, acute respiratory, COPD, chest pain r/o, CHF, SCAI A
