The convenience of an authenticator app allows users to securely certify a death record *anywhere*, using *any* browser, whereas the biometric device option requires users to register fingerprints and use an installed biometric device.

Any authenticator app can be used to link your information to OVERS, and the best part is that it can be installed on any smart phone and used within *minutes*.

The Authenticator App is an option on the OVERS Certify Screen. Once enabled, the Authenticator drop-down menu defaults to Authenticator.
